

We have interviewed cousins in California, Montana and Oklahoma. We then traveled to California and Texas and researched records in San Francisco, Galveston, Port Arthur, and Houston. After putting all this together it appears our family story is this:

Wilhem Jilge Sr. and Matilde had a family of several children in Germany. The town of Jilgeburg is mentioned but was destroyed by the war. Wilhelm Sr. possibly died and left her a widow. About 1880 the seaport area of Texas decided to build a town called Aurora east of Galveston and close to the Louisiana border. They advertised heavily in Germany and Holland for carpenters to come and settle there to build the town. Wilhem G. Jilge, the oldest son and his mother Matilde arrived from Germany in 1881 to help build that city. Whether he brought a wife or married a girl in Texas is not known, it is thought she was wealthy in her own right. According to the history books the emigrants got a good start on building it. In 1886 Wilhem had a baby girl named Wilhelmina and the mother died in childbirth. They were Catholic and mass was held once a week by saddle back priests who came from Galveston to one of the settlers home. Where she was buried is unknown because also in 1886 the town was destroyed by a huge hurricane. They decided not to rebuild Aurora.

About that same time the railroad was completed from New Orleans to San Francisco. Surely there were stage or railroads established to that main line. In 1903 the townsite of Aurora was rebuilt again and became the town of Port Arthur and just north the Dutch town of Nederland was established.

In the meantime 1884 - 1886 Berta M (Jilge) Moritz, the daughter of Matilde became a widow in Germany with three small children and decided to come to America to her mother. She brought her two young brothers, Herman (16yrs) and Adolph (11yrs) as stowaways. The ships coming in were very crowded and she described the sickness that prevailed. Her baby daughter died on the way and she arrived with her two boys Frank, (5yrs) and Elmer (3yrs) Were these two brothers living with her in Germany?

Somehow they all arrived in San Francisco, we think by rail, because we find Wilhelm G. working as a carpenter in 1888 and can track him there for many years. He obviously married again and had more children, who we know very little about. Adolph and Herman told the story later that they did not like San Francisco and came to Oklahoma City area as young men. Did they encounter an earthquake in San Francisco? Or did they hear of fortune and land in Oklahoma. Did they come by rail? Adolph and Herman both started families there. In 1915 Herman took his family on to Montana and stayed. Adolph and Herman both had carpenter skills. The descendants in both California and Oklahoma also have the skills of the building trade as you will read. They became painters, tile setters, wall paper hangers and carpenters.

Berta M. Moritz soon married a man named Thude who had two children, her young boys Frank and Elmer took the name Thude and then Berta proceeded to have two more children, Otto and Antoinette Thude. In 1906 she briefly married a man named Reinhard Boggs and Wilhem G. Jilge (her brother) was a witness. She later married a man named Carl Bowman and outlived him.

There are other children of Wilhem Sr mentioned, Lester, Minnie, Otto. Did they come to America also? It is thought that at least one brother stayed in Germany and Adolph mentions a sister. (See his notes)

1S. Mathilde

ACTION: Does Norma still have the family tree referred to below?

BIO: As this story unfolds it appears that our Berta did come to America to see family as Dave Thude was told. It looks like Mathilde and her son Wilhelm came to Port Arthur, TX near Galveston in 1881. Did Mathilde's husband also come? Wilhelm's first wife dies shortly after their first child is born in Port Arthur in 1886. The child is Wilhelmina "Our Aunt Minnie".

In 1891 Wilhelm is shown in San Francisco directory with Mathilde as a widow. She only appears one more time, in 1897 in the City Directory as Tillie, a widow.

Berta (her daughter) in the meantime was married in Germany to Mr. Morritz and became a widow there? She then leaves for America about 1886 with her 3 children to find her mother, and as the family story goes came to Galveston, TX where they all went to San Francisco together..

BIO: Bernice Carrassi her great granddaughter says "Tillie" was a midwife and knew that Berta's family name was Jilge.

To further support this, in 1906, when Berta now a widow of Mr. Otto Thude remarried a third time to Reinhard Boggs, her witness was William Jilge.

BIO: I searched the Social Security records and came up with several Jilge's in OK and MT. After a few phone calls I connected with a Mrs. Arthur Jilgee (Florence) who told me the story of her father-in-law as she knew it. The story appears the same as the one we have of Berta. Mrs. Jilge gave me the name of a niece, Barbara Jilge who is doing family research. I couldn't contact her. I have put the family in as she describes them. I talked to several of the Oklahoma and Montana family and they are sending information.

Her story: Herman age 16 and Adolph age 11 stowed away on a ship to Galveston to find their brother Wilhelm and their mother abt 1884/85. A sister also came named Berta who was not married. Probably meant widowed. They came to America because they were to be put in Military School and one to become a Priest. They went to California with Wilhelm but did not like it and came to Oklahoma where they raised families. Some went on to Montana.

AKA: The Jilge name I believe was pronounced Jil-gee, it is unusual as it only appears with this family in San Francisco in the period 1887 to 1953.

SOURCE: Norma Jilgee says she has a copy of a family tree that was done by the generation after Berta. She is sending a copy.

2. Wilhelm G JILGE Jr

ACTION: Need to find the marriage cert of Wilhelm and Augusta and Wilhelm and his first wife (Texas?)

Also any marriage of son & dau. Marriage Cert may give other information on the parents. Need naturalization records.

BIO: (1994) after interview of Elsie Newby, data from San Francisco Directory, and census information.

It appears that William came to TX with Mathilde (mother) in 1881 when about 26 yrs old. He possibly married in Texas and was living in Aurora, (Port Arthur), TX where his first wife died Sept 1886 and his only child of that marriage, Minnie was born. Then the whole family goes to San Francisco where he is listed in 1888 as a carpenter and is living at 23 Howard. He married Augusta about June 1902 in San Francisco. They had four children Alma, Elsa, Hilda and Madeline by the 1900 census. Two more children Edith and William Jr show up in the City Directory and the 1910 census. Augusta says on the census that she came to America in 1884.

Madeline disappears from the City Directory after 1926 possibly married a Mcgreddie. Edith "Vivian" had a son & daughter and moved south. William Jr does not show up after 1938, did he go to war? William G./Augusta are listed until 1939 in the City Directory, then they all disappear from San Francisco. Did he die then or move out of the area. Elsie Newby visited with Wilhelm a few times and he told her they were from Alsace-Lorraine Germany and talked of the land being both French and German. Elsie Newby was Minnie's (Wilhemina) daughter-in-law.

BIO: (1996) After researching in Galveston and Port Arthur libraries, courthouses and talking with local historians and genealogists it appears:

The port of Galveston had ships coming in from Germany usually through New York. One line called the Star of the West came from New York and went all the way to San Francisco. The Galveston port wasn't very deep so the ships stayed out and the passengers were brought in on smaller boats. Over east on the coast was another port called Sabine Pass. It was famous for the major successful battle held there during the Civil War where a small group crippled the ships coming in from the North. There was a small town called Aurora started after the War and it was heavily advertised in Germany and Holland for the wonderful temperatures, farm land, water, new railroads coming in etc. About 1895 there was a spur railroad from Galveston to Houston where the mainline railroad was crossing from New Orleans to San Francisco. There was also a bustling business with steam ships traveling from Galveston to New Orleans and stopping off in the Sabine Pass area.

So, it would seem !! Wilhelm is a carpenter and wants to come to America with his wife and mother. They come in 1881/2 according to the census of 1900/1910. In September of 1896 his wife dies in childbirth having (Wilhemina Maria Jilge) while in the Aurora, TX area.

The family story says that she was very well to do and it is believed they were Roman Catholic. In 1886 there was not a church in the area although a "Saddle bag Priest" would come over from Galveston to say Mass at the home of one of the pioneer settlers. There is no known cemetery

that early and the local historian says there is not a tombstone with the Gilge name. So perhaps there was only a private grave. The town of Aurora was not developing as the settlers had planned and the other problem of the year 1886 was the terrible hurricane that hit Oct 12th. That storm destroyed what town there was and everything around it. Many people were killed.

In the meantime the family was probably waiting for the arrival of Berta, her children, and possibly her's and Wilhelm's stow away young brothers. Did they arrive in 1886 and all immediately leave by train for San Francisco? They probably went by steam ship to Galveston, then by rail to Houston. The storm arrived and wiped out the grave. If they came to San Francisco by ship around the "Horn" the story was never passed down to the family. Berta did tell that she lost "her papers" somewhere on that trip. It would seem that they would have train travel in Germany and would probably both prefer that way to travel plus it would be more affordable.

The stow away brothers went to San Francisco but soon decided they didn't like it and settled in Oklahoma to raise there families. One later took his family to Montana.

The little town of Aurora did not survive and much later in 1903 became the town of Port Arthur, TX. Wilhemina "Our Minnie" always told the family she was born and her mother died in Port Arthur.

The research needs to be continued in Germany. Possibly the ship they embarked on will have records and the name of Wilhelm's wife. That may show where they were from and going to. I don't believe we will ever find any evidence here in Texas. Many of the ship records in Galveston were destroyed in the terrible hurricane of 1900 that killed 6,000 people.

BIRTH: It appears Alcaze-Lorraine was the place where Berta came from, possibly born there. Dave Thude remembers she came from Magdeburg-Sachsen-Anhalt, but this was more likely where she lived while married.

BIO: Mrs. Berta Moritz, widow, married Mr. Thude after arriving in America. She came by ship as a widow with her three children, Frank, daughter, & Ernest. Frank was about 5 years old. They came by "Steerage", so very crowded and poor. On the trip the baby daughter died of Typhoid. It is thought she came into Galveston. (Although Galveston records do not show this). It is possible that all papers will be found in the New York ports and they were left off in Texas. How did they arrive in San Francisco? She had family here waiting for her, we think in Port Arthur, Texas. They probably came to San Francisco by train. Family feels she married Mr. Otto Thude in San Francisco. Mr. Thude possibly had two boys, Harry J. & William J. Thude. It is not thought that she ever became a naturalized citizen.

She probably docked in Galveston then went to what is now called Port Arthur a few miles away. At that time it was called Aurora, TX. In 1886 the town was wiped out by a hurricane and about that year the railroad opened from New Orleans to San Francisco.

BIO: Otto Thude and Berta had a son Otto Jr and daughter Antoinette. Antoinette married Joseph Litzius and they had three children, Bernice who married a Carrisi, and sons Joseph and Edward Litzius. Antoinette d: June 1983.

BIO:

Frank Alfred Thude her son had a cousin named Aunt Minnie. Bernice Carrisi has a photo of Antoinette her daughter, and Minnie. They were cousins. Joe Litzius and Bernice remember this about Aunt Minnie. Minnie was married first to a Mr. Newby. They had a son Lawrence who married Elsie Goodneough. Lawrence was a great golfer. They had two sons Edward and Robert Newby. They are still alive in San Carlos and Fresno, CA. Minnie married a second time to Mr. Hodeck and died living on Woodrow street in Daly City.

Minnie's father Wilhelm Jilge and Berta were brother and sister.

We talked to Robert Newby by phone and he gave us his mothers number in Fresno. She had additional information as you will see in notes. Frank and Minnie were first cousins, it appears. We visited Elsie, Minnie's daughter in law in Oct 1995.

BIO: Bernice story: Says they came from Alsace-Lorraine. Berta had very poor eyesight and in Germany before they came, the doctors did surgery. They took both eyeballs out and cleaned them and then replaced them. Antoinette and Bernice inherited her small eyes. She says her grandmother spoke fluent English but read and wrote in German.

She thinks Berta met Otto Thude on the ship over. He was from Berlin. He was a barber but his family were in the Jewelry business. He cut hair in

San Francisco for many important people. He had children also but she did not know how many. Berta was coming here to her family the Gilge's. She said Berta's family name was Gilge. (Gilgee) (A William Gilge was a witness to her marriage to Boggs.) She said Berta kept a photo of the Kaiser on her mantlepiece and during World War I a neighbor called the FBI. Antionette talked her way out of it but she kept it on the fireplace anyway. (wonder if there is a report of that in the FBI files, possibly will tell us her parents names) (Otto Thude was already in San Francisco when Berta came)

Joe Litzius says she lived with them some after Charles (Carl?) Boltman died Charles died when Joe was about six years old. Berta and Charles lived on Athens street and they owned a fair amount of land where the old dairy was. She lived alone alot for the next 10 years and possibly had some sort of pension from Charles when he worked for the newspaper. She loved to play cards with Joe and she lived until just before he graduated from high school in 1933. She didn't get along as well with Bernice and Ed because they wouldn't play cards with her.

(The newspaper needs to be contacted for the correct spelling of his name, I did not find it in the City Directories)

BIO: Berta told Joe, that living in Berlin, Germany she was expected to get up very early in the morning and they would sweep the streets. He said she was a fanatic about keeping a clean house and passed that on to her daughter Antoinette.

BIO: In 1902 her sons, Frank, and Otto were living in the same address as a Harry J. Thude. I believe this Harry J Thude and William J Thude were the children of Otto Thude before she married him.

He landed in Galveston to meet with his brother Wilhelm who was older. Adolph came with his brother Herman who was 16 yrs old. They went to California with Wilhelm but did not stay and left for Oklahoma about 1890. He was Catholic. He was also a good carpenter as were his brothers Herman and Wilhelm. Wonder if his father was? He and his brother Herman settled on the west side of Oklahoma near the Texas border in the counties of Beckham and Roger Mills and started their families. It appears that by 1904 though Adolph moved over to the Oklahoma county area. Herman moved over later.

He and Sophronia had a leased farm where they raised cotton and corn. He did not teach his children German or did not talk much about Germany.

(Wonder if he always worried because they were stowaways)

BIO: Sharon Jilge (granddaughter) thinks it was 1889 when they came over.

She asked her grandfather where he came from and he couldn't remember but said he remembered windmills. (Is it possible the ship came through Holland?) see story in Sharon's notes about a brother who asked them to come home to

Germany to fight in the war.

BIO: Bertha Jilge called after reviewing her research on the family (Jul 1994) Adolph came from Jilgeburg, Germany 60 miles north of Berlin (no longer on the map) Adolph died at Florence (Mrs. Lewis) Jilge's home. (Other family also remembered the town Jilgeburg being spoken of, but said it was destroyed during the war.

BIO: Florence Jilge remembers a letter coming about 1945/46 addressed to Lester Jilge and she felt it was for Lewis Lester Jilge. She gave it to Lewis. She never heard who the letter was from.

Frank was raised a Catholic. He went to Catholic grammar school for a time.

His mother Berta remarried a man named Otto Thude and he and Ernest took the name Thude while growing up. Was he legally adopted. Where??

This information from Ward Howard, Denise Mendonca and Dave Thude:

Who has photo's, any documents??? for Frank Thude.

BIO: Art remembers visiting his mother on Shrader street as a child of 4 years. He remembers being in a wagon at the top of the hill and Jimmy let go of the wagon. It stopped half way down the long sidewalk into the side of a car backing out of a driveway. They didn't get a lickin because everyone was sure he was hurt badly. The Shradder house didn't have much of a yard so they played in the street. Ruth was living with her parents at Shrader street. Delores was living at home.

Another day Art remembers Delores dressing Jimmy and himself up as little girls with makeup. Jimmy and Art played in Golden Gate Park that visit. Art remembers climbing over the bridge in the Japanese tea gardens.

Joe Litzius says the house on Foerster was across from Sunnyside school. And close to St. Pinbars church. Frank's kids all went to the school. The backyard was small and very narrow.

BIO:

When the earthquake occurred his mother Berta was living on Mission or Market. The landlords son was in the militia, Berta was on her porch with her dog. The dog was howling and this guy told her to shut up the dog, she didn't and he shot the dog. Frank and his brother Ernest found the guy later in a dark alley and took care of him. Bernice says the dog was a beautiful St. Bernard. The family camped out in the street. Antoinette was a 11 year old child and was terrified all of her life of earthquakes.

BIO: Ward Howard Interview:

Frank was in the San Francisco earthquake, He was a bricklayer and tile man. He had a hunched back from a fall off of a ladder when he was rebuilding after the earthquake doing some roof work. He had Typhoid sometime in his life, and became bald in his 30's. He was known to be strict and thrifty. He and Ruth separated a few times in their marriage. They had a baby girl die at six weeks of pneumonia. Frank had broke a leg at the time and the family took it hard. He loved to play pinochle. If he was not busy he would pull out a deck of

cards and play solitaire. He was red haired. They rented a large home on Shradder. After Frank's death, Ruth stayed with the children a few weeks at a time. Ward Howard thinks there was a half sister named Antoinette, and someone called Aunt Minnie. Antionette's dad was called Frank Rose (Thude)?? Frank was called Pa by the family.

BIO:

Frank became a Tile setter by accident, after the Earthquake he was looking at a Help wanted sign and a guy came up and talked him into setting tile. He worked at other jobs over the years, fry cook, guard etc. but after World War II he again became a tile setter. At one time he was the Night Watchman for Majestic Clothing store. After the war he was the foreman for a WPA or PWA project. As foreman and Union he worked 5 days a week, his men three days.

BIO: He had an old Model T Ford he drove without a rear view mirror. Ward tells the story of his driving. He would stick his hand out and turn never looking in a mirror.

Ward tells the story of Frank falling off a two story building into the sand on his head wearing a Derby Hat. He was hunched over from that fall all of his life. They took him to the hospital but he became concious about half way there.

He owned a St. Bernard dog when Al was small, when they lived by Sunnyvale School? One day the dog bit the child. Frank dug a hole, got a gun, killed the dog and buried him. Is this another St. Bernard??

I would like to be together with MA, it would be better for MA but I am afraid. What do you think. Mrs. Stuard told me that Ma wants me to come back. What should I do. Ho, wish you was home, poor little Betty she needs you. Well Len I will close for this time. Hoping you are well. I know you are not happy.
